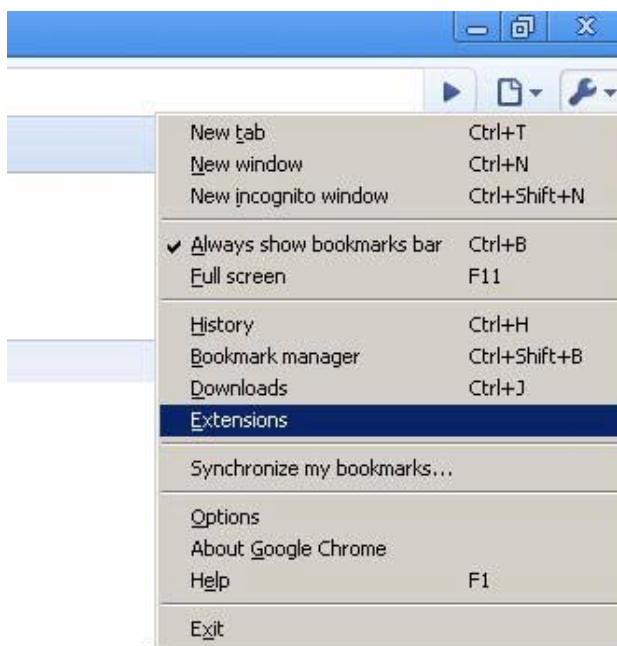

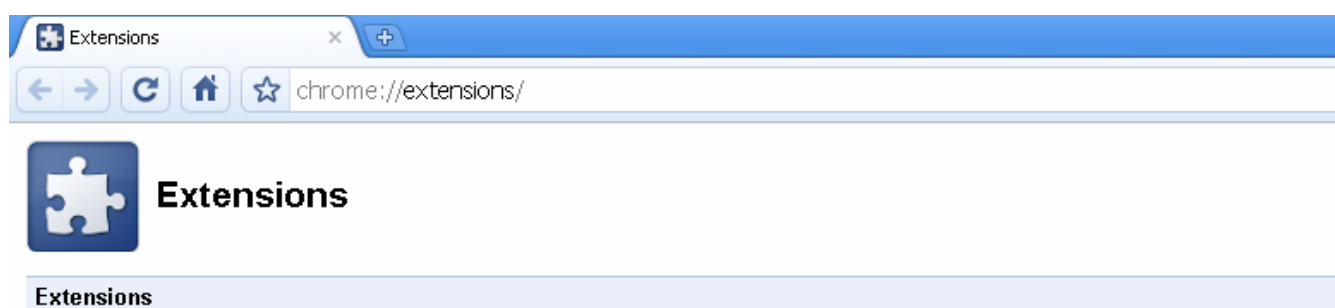
This user's manual is to help you install and use the DVR remote view using Google Chrome

1. Download and Install Extension

Click "Extension" in Google Chrome configuration dropdown list to go to the extension management interface.



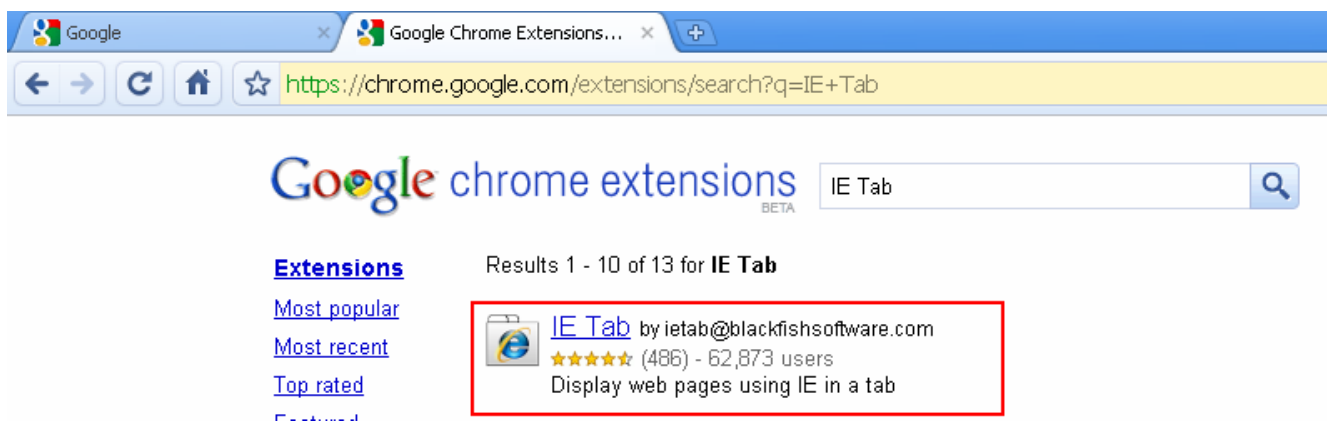
The Google Chrome extension management interface is as below.





Click “Browse the gallery” and search for “IE Tab” extension.

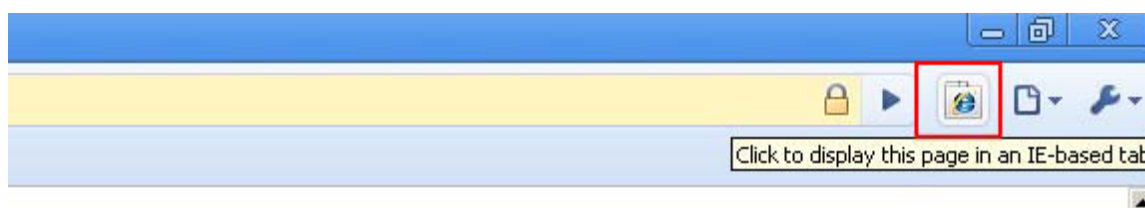


Install the latest “IE Tab” extension (version 1.0.11208.1).



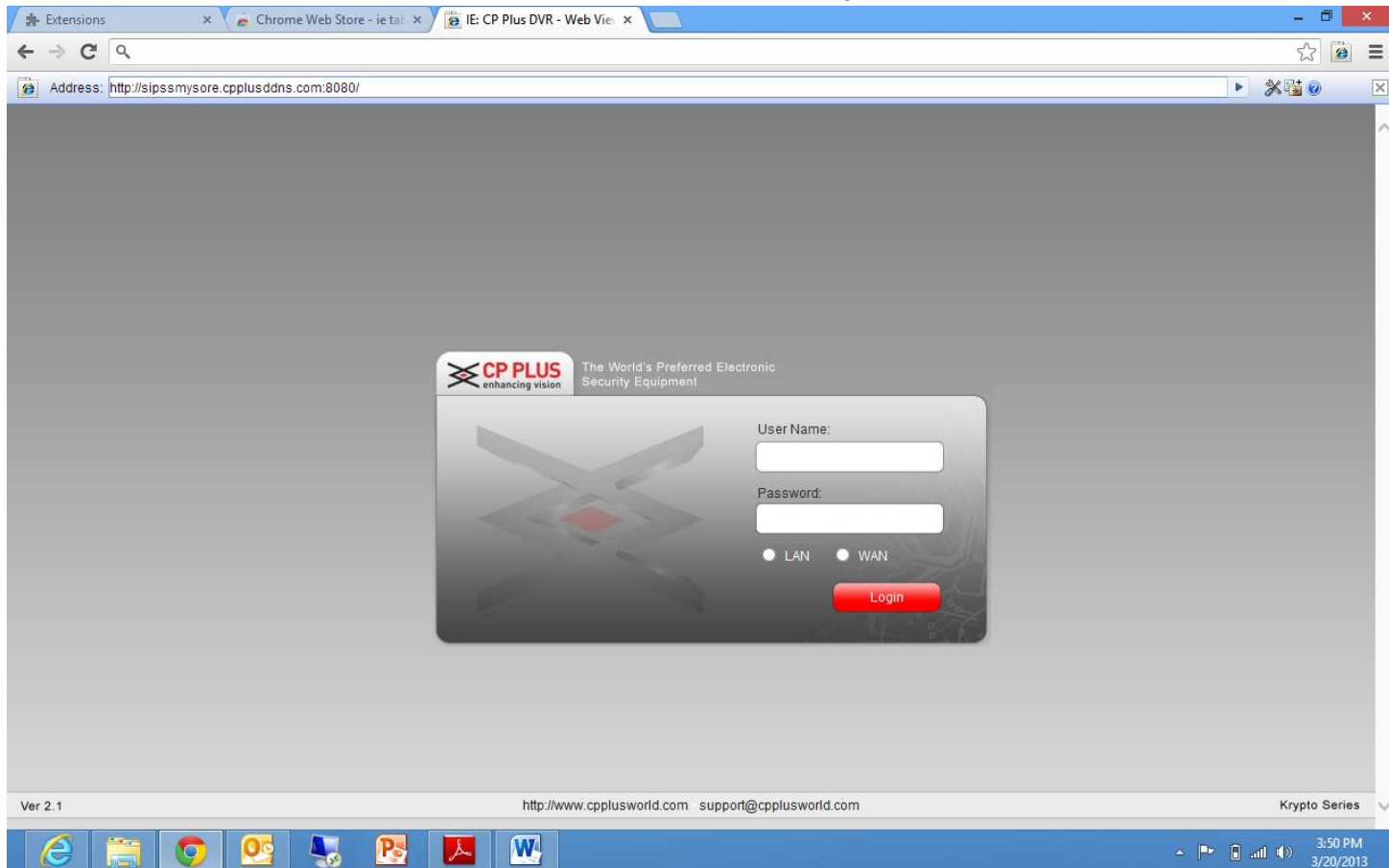
